

Guide to using WiFi

Your library has a WiFi network that requires you to log-in with a web browser. Accessing network and/or WiFi settings differs depending on your operating system and device.

Connecting to the library's network using a laptop

Windows Operating Systems

1. Access your Network connections:
 - Windows XP: Start Menu > Control Panel > Network Connections
 - Windows Vista: Start Menu > Connect To
 - Windows 7: lower right toolbar > network icon
 - Windows 8: Move the mouse to the upper-right corner of the screen and select Settings > WiFi
2. Click on the network named **'MCLibrary'**
3. Click Connect
4. Open a web browser
5. Click on **"Continue to the Internet."**

iOS Operating Systems

1. Click on **System Preferences** from the Apple Menu
2. Double click on the **Network** logo
3. Select **AirPort** or **WiFi** from the list on the left. If the status is **Off**, click **Turn AirPort or WiFi On**.
4. Click on the network named **'MCLibrary.'**
5. Click Connect
6. Open a web browser
7. Click on **"Continue to the Internet."**

Connecting to the library's network using a mobile device

1. Click on the settings icon
2. Tap "Wi-Fi" and turn on if needed
3. Tap the network named **'MCLibrary'**
4. Tap Connect
5. Open your Browser
6. Click on **"Continue to the Internet."**
