

consumer reports – quick tips

What is Consumer Reports?

- Consumer Reports is an expert, independent, non-profit organization that provides reviews and comparisons of consumer products.
- Access to their online reviews are available for free from your library; all you need is your library card number and pin.

Where do I find Consumer Reports?

- Access Consumer Reports by clicking on the blue eResources tab on the left side of the Middlesex County Library website. Once on the eResources page look for the Consumer Reports button.
- You can also find Consumer Reports on the Lifelong Learning page and on the Alphabetical List of all eResources.
- If you are not in the library you will need to enter your library card number and pin (usually the last four digits of your phone number).

Searching with Consumer Reports

There are several ways to search:

- Type a product name or type into the search box. (ie. Kobo or tablets)
- Click on the A-Z Index to view the full list of products.



- Browse the product categories under the “Find Ratings” menu.
